

SECRETARY REPORT FROM 09.04.2022 to 27.05.2022.

22.04.2022: Meeting with Regional Director, JIADA on Various problem faced by Industries. This has reference to our submission on JIADA matter before the Industry Secretary in its meeting held on 16.09.2021 at Radisson Hotel & dt.04.02.2022 at your office.

1. Propose of JIADA – Development and growth of MSME purpose not to earn revenue but social motive for development.
2. Advisory Committee Formation & its Quarterly meeting.
3. One Time Settlement Scheme (OTS) for DIC/JIADA dues.
4. Non Transparent Policy about fixation of Land rent and maintenance charges.
5. JIADA dues: Waiver of Interest on delayed payment during Covid period and Extension of Installment period for MSME.
6. JIADA Land to MSME: Incase of multiple application, Land allotment should be done by Lottery instead of present practice of auction/bidding.
7. Non availability of civic amenities in JIADA Industrial areas, waste handling and waste disposal plant.
8. Land should be earmarked separately for service sector and manufacturing sector to avoid conflict and disturbance.
9. Small Plots for Micro unit should be reserved.
10. JIADA had wrongly charged GST on Land price during 2018/2019 and had assured to refund back the GST wrongly collected. The said refund is still pending.
11. Charging Interest on Land rent and maintenance charges without service of Annual bill.
12. Physical Possession of Plots not being ensured/implemented.
13. Individual pending issues if any.

27.04.2022: Meeting with different industry associations from all over the country under Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister (MSME), Sri Narayan Rana and various officers of MSME department at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on 27.04.2022 (02:30 PM - 06:30 PM). Attended by Hony. Secretary Sri Ajay Kr. Dadheech & E.C. Member Sri Shivam Singh.

We have few suggestions for your attention and action please.

- 1) **GEM Portal**:- The Portal is not smooth to work on viz Registration, Tender participation, quotation, Auction/Bidding process etc. Detailed paper has been submitted on 13.12.2021 with office of DC (MSME).
- 2) **MSEFC**:- We take this opportunity to highlight the matters related to MSEFC.
 - i) There is no uniform practice to conduct regular meeting of MSEFC. We suggest – one fix date every month as MSEFC meeting day.
 - ii) Pending cases beyond 180 days should be monitored at Central level and reasons should be sought for delay.
 - iii) Suitable legal teeth should be provided for execution of Award.
 - iv) Uniform SOP should be framed for uniformity in proceeding.
 - v) Award/Decree of MSEFC is theoretically considered as land revenue arrear but practically it is not enforced. Recovery officer should be made accountable for timely enforcement and recovery of the Award/Decree.

3) **Abnormal Increase in Raw material cost:**

Abnormal Increase in raw material cost has adversely effected the MSMEs. During last 3 months prices of raw materials has increased ranging from 150% to 300%.

The input cost of raw material source has not increased in such proportion. Large producers having captive mines have hardly incurred any additional cost.

Suitable measures is desired to ensure availability of raw materials to MSME by controlling the prices for the Survival/Existence of MSMEs.

4) **Timely payment to MSMEs:**

Presently the steps taken to ensure timely payment to MSME's have not provided the desired results. We suggest:-

- i) TREDs should be made effective, non-compliance should be penalized. State Government State undertakings/utilities should be compelled by statute to route all MSME payments through TReds.
- ii) Disbursement of any Subsidy / Grant to large Industries / Corporate under Central/State Schemes should be linked to clearance of unpaid payment to MSME. Incase of pending overdue payment of MSME, matching amount should be held back till MSME overdue payment is cleared.

5) **Separate Policy for Manufacturing & Service sector:**

Manufacturing MSMEs cannot be treated at par with Service Sector. Manufacturing MSMEs have different challenges for their survival and therefore deserves support - availability of land, finance, technology, etc.

- 6) Timely release of Grants/Subsidies/Subvention. Delay in disbursement beyond reasonable period impacts its purpose.

CLCSS Subsidy were released after more than one year of application. Interest Subvention to MSME announced as Covid relief measure during 2020 were later refused citing non availability of adequate budgetary support.

- 7) Electricity Duty charged by State Power Discom should be brought in preview of GST, to reduce cost of production.
- 8) Diesel consumed by MSMEs in D.G. Sets should be brought in the preview of GST to bring down production cost.

Issues are many and we request for an opportunity for detailed submission.

आज दिनांक 28 अप्रैल 2022 को दक्षिण पूर्व रेलवे, राँची रेल मंडल कार्यालय के सभाकक्ष में मंडल रेल प्रबंधक श्री प्रदीप गुप्ता की अध्यक्षता में मंडल राजभाषा कार्यान्वयन समिति राँची की बैठक संपन्न हुई | इस बैठक पर राजभाषा विभाग द्वारा मंडल पर सभी विभागों द्वारा हिंदी में किए गए कार्यों की प्रगति, पावर पॉइंट प्रेजेंटेशन द्वारा दर्शाई गई |

इस बैठक में मंडल के विभिन्न विभागों के 40 कर्मचारियों को कार्यालय के अपने दैनिक कार्यों को राजभाषा में करने के लिए मंडल रेल प्रबंधक श्री प्रदीप गुप्ता द्वारा प्रशस्ति पत्र एवं नगद राशि देकर पुरस्कृत किया गया |

बैठक के अध्यक्ष मंडल रेल प्रबंधक श्री प्रदीप गुप्ता ने अपने विचार व्यक्त करते हुए कहा कि मंडल में राजभाषा नियमों, अधिनियमों एवं आदेशों का पूरा- पूरा पालन किया जा रहा है, सभी स्टेशनों पर उद्घोषणाएँ हिन्दी एवं अंग्रेजी दोनों भाषाओं में की जा रही हैं।

साथ ही कहा कि हिंदी में प्रशिक्षित कर्मचारियों, आशुलिपिकों और टंकक से अधिक से अधिक कार्य हिंदी में कराया जाए, वेबसाइट द्विभाषी होनी चाहिए, संरक्षा परिपत्र भी अंग्रेजी और हिंदी दोनों भाषाओं में होना चाहिए, स्टेशन के रजिस्टर भी द्विभाषी होनी चाहिए तथा उन्होंने कहा कि प्रत्येक विभाग को कम से कम 80% कार्य हिंदी में करने का प्रयास करना चाहिए | उन्होंने इस पर जोर दिया कि हिंदी एक बहुत ही सरल एवं सुंदर भाषा है तथा हम सभी हिंदी भाषी हैं अतः इसे समझना और कार्य करना बहुत आसान है | साथ ही हिन्दी में सभी कार्यों को सुचारु एवं निर्बाध ढंग से करने की सलाह दी तथा कोरोना संक्रमण से पूर्व हो रहे सभी हिन्दी संबन्धित गतिविधियों को पुनः आरंभ करने को कहा |

04.05.2022: Letter to the Managing Director, Jharkhand State Food & Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd., JSFC Bhawan, Ranchi for additional incentive for milling charge due to increase of power tariff, fuel cost, minimum wages & other cost. We have requested to increase milling charge incentive of Rs.20/- per Quintal in addition to the normal milling charges of Rs.20 per Quintal is highly inadequate compared to other States paying additional incentive of Rs.70 per Quintal.
