MEETING WITH CHIEF SECRETARY:

15.07.2025: Meeting with Chief Secretary on issues related to MSMEs. It was attended by President Sri Anjay Pachariwala, Hony. Secretary Sri Shivam Singh, Vice President Sri Randhir Kr. Sharma & Sri Keshav Chhawchharia. We have highlighted various issues related to MSMEs. The Chief Secretary assured us of prompt action. We also suggested reconstitution of a MSME committee to be chaired by Development Commissioner so that issues of MSMEs may be resolved at regular intervals

The department is of the view for evaluation of Portal technically for the present single window through JAP-IT. and seeking suggestions for improvement.

The meeting was at a very preliminary level. The Industries Department has just started thinking about improvements in the Single Window System. As per JAP-IT the operating Portal is very old and needs to be changed technically.

- Ensuring proper monitoring and verification of the implementation of energy efficiency measures.

MEETING WITH STATE LEVEL BANKER'S COMMITTEE(SLBC):

18.01.2025: Meeting with SLBC. It was attended by Hony. Secretary Shri Shivam Singh.

- C.D. ratio more than 50.22% for the first time in Jharkhand. 87% is the national CD ratio average.
- Re KYC pending for many accounts in the State.
- Fraud in some government accounts has surfaced. The secretary finance was of the view that if fraud has been caused due to negligence of banks there banks should bear the loss due to the fraud. 1930 is the complaint no for cyber frauds.
- Banker's are also concerned that industries are not having clear lands due to CNT and other acts and they are not able to provide loans to industries.
- Bankers are requesting government to provide proper lands for industries as even banking is lacking behind due to non development of Industries.
- Committee has been set up to look after low CD ratio for Jharkhand under Chairmanship of Secretary Finance.

14.02.2025: Meeting with SLBC. It was attended by Chairman, Sub Committee Sri H.P. Biyani & Hony. Secretary Shri Shivam Singh.

There is a demand for warehousing storage for food products. Cold Storage/Godown/Silos has a subsidy of 30%. Current capacity for storage is only about 10% of the total produce. Also, items such as Fig (Anjeer), Strawberry and Dragon fruit etc. have a great advantage in Jharkhand. Banks highlighted that they're facing problem in mortgage due to CNT and other land laws.

PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojna – Free Electricity up to 300 units every month to household. Rs. 75,000/- Crore is the total outlay under this scheme. Subsidy of Rs. 30,000/- Per KW for upto 2 – KW for Solar installation. Additional 18,000 for 1KW. Total capping at 78,000/- for KCC limit increased from 3 to 5 lacs.

14.05.2025: Meeting with SLBC. Attended by Chairman, Banking Sub Committee Sri H.P. Biyani & Hony. Secretary Shri Shivam Singh.

About 65000 accounts declassified in Micro segment by Indusind Bank.

- State's NPA increases by Rs. 746 crores on YoY basis. In forms of percentage the NPA has decreased by 4.38% compared to previous year, as of March 2025 NPA is at 5.32%.
- Banks and CDM's were advised to explore expansion of Branch. Network in the state so the state may reach national average of branches per lakh populations.
- Birsa Kisan Portal launch for all schemes and benefits of farmers.
- Smr Shilpi Neha Tirkey pointed out that because of CNT big industries cannot come so MSMEs are the only hope for such a state.
- CD ratio 50.68% in the last FY. Target is set at 60% for current FY.
- Sohrai has been gives GI tag.
- Silli, Dharmpur village, new cafeteria has been developed by NABARD as an initial promotion for tourism.
- RBI directed banks to use bank.in as website so that banks can shift to this domain by October. This will help in curbing frauds.

MEETING WITH SIDBI:

27.09.2024: Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) & Collaborating with JSIA Organised on MSME Outreach Meet Program at JSIA Conference Hall, Kokar, Ranchi. Presentation on various products offered by SIDBI was discussed.

30.12.2024: Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) convened it's 5th meeting of Standing Committee on Customer Service **through MS Teams (Online)**. It was attended by Past President Sri Philip Mathew.

The meeting was chaired by Dy. MD, SIDBI. JSIA made the following suggestions:-

- Funds allocated for various schemes should be earmarked for eastern States on a proportionate basis rather than on a first come first serve basis open to all India customers. This will help in better participation and promotion of funds and schemes in the eastern region of the country.

- CGTMSE is not being promoted and thus we requested that banks should consciously promote the scheme and try to give maximum loans under this scheme.
- The issue of name not being verified in NEFT/RTGS transactions was raised by us.

The Committee appreciated the suggestions and ensured that the same will be reviewed for future consideration.

03.03.2025: Meeting with SIDBI Standing Committee. It was attended by IPP, Sri Philip Mathew.

MEETING WITH PROVIDENT FUND COMMISSIONER:

07.01.2025: Meeting with the EPF Commissioner. Vice President, Shri Randhir Sharma has visited EPFO Office at Hinoo Ranchi to have a general discussion regarding application for Pension on Higher wages to EPFO.

Commissioner has requested JSIA for awareness for UAN activation, a list of establishments whose UAN are pending for activation being shared for initiative regarding activation of UAN of establishment.

25.07.2025 (Friday) Meeting with EPFO & ESIC at JSIA on “PM VIKSIT BHARAT ROZGAR YOJNA”. It is an employment link incentive scheme. Also an amnesty scheme is launched wherein the department has assured that no queries will be raised on new registrations for the said period.

MEETING WITH JBVNL:

12.03.2025: Meeting with GM, Ranchi Area Board, JBVNL was held at his office in Kusai Colony. It was attended by our president Shri Anjay Pachariwala, Secretary Shivam Singh, Shri Keshav Chawcharia Shri Vivek Bagla and Shri Chittaranjan Dubey. Various issues were discussed regarding problems of various members and also policy matters.

30.04.2025: Electricity Tariff: Tariff for JBVNL was announced on 30.04.2025. There was a very nominal increase in 0.05 paise in LTIS/HT tariff with no change in Fixed/Demand charge against proposal of 25% increase. Our team effort has yielded big relief to all consumers.

MEETING WITH JSERC:

16.11.2024: JSIA has given the following suggestions to JSERC :-

- a) To keep a nominal fee of Rs. 5000/- for filing of case and waive it for economically weaker individuals and group of individuals.
- b) Neatly handwritten petition in English/Hindi may be accepted instead of accepting only typed petition.

25.03.2025: Public Hearing, JSERC at IMA Hall, Karmatoli. The hearing was attended by President Sri Anjay Pachariwala, Hony Secretary Sri Shivam Singh & Sri Deepak Kr. Maroo, Sri. Sourabh Modi, Sri Sandeep Jajodia, Sri Piyush Agarwal, Sri Ankit Pachariwala and others. JSIA strongly opposed the tariff proposal and highlighted the short comings in their tariff proposal and present supply situation.

26.03.2025: JSERC State Advisory Committee Meeting. It was attended by President Anjay Pachariwala. Major issue discussed was the tariff by JBVNL and its functioning.

MEETING WITH REGIONAL DIRECTOR, JIADA:

13.01.2025: Meeting with Managing Director, JIADA. It was attended by President Sri Anjay Pachariwala, Hony. Secretary Sri Shivam Singh, Chairman, Sub Committee Sri Deepak Kr. Maroo, E.C. Member Sri Bijay Choudhary & Sri Nikhil Kedia.

JSIA has presented various suggestions to be incorporated in the regulations of JIADA. A detailed point by point representation was made in this regard and the same was appreciated by the Managing Director, JIADA. She immediately agreed to incorporate many of the suggestions.

1. कर्मचारी के व्याप्ति के लिए वेतन की अधिकतम सीमा 21000/- को बढ़ाने के संबंध में।
2. नए डिस्पेंसरी और शाखा कार्यालय खोलने के संबंध में।
3. रिजनल बोर्ड की बैठक नहीं होने के संबंध में।
4. MIMP के साथ बीमित व्यक्ति नहीं जोड़े जाने के संबंध में।

श्रीमती अर्चना तिर्की, राज्य चिकित्सा अधिकारी के द्वारा भी इस मुद्दे पर अपनी राय रखी और सभी संगठनों से इस पर सहयोग की अपील की।

Details suggest the following:-

1. ESI Contribution may be made optional for employees earning more than Rs. 21,000, however the contribution should be capped at the calculation which is arrived by considering a wage of Rs. 21,000.
2. Currently a nominal amount is charged per year for persons who have retired. Mostly in the old age people are forgetful and their dependants may not be educated enough to carry on the formalities on yearly basis. We suggest a one-time payment facility for 10/20 years should also be available as an option to people who want to opt for one-time payment. This will help the insured person and their dependant to avail the facilities without any hiccups.
3. Simplified process with minimal formalities may be implemented for enrolling such workers to facilitate employers for easy compliance
4. Since the number of persons insured in the state has crossed 6.26 lakhs it has become mandatory to have proper facilities in terms of manpower (doctors, nurses, support staff etc) and medicines availability at the ESIC centres. Against the sanctioned post of 84 doctors, only 22 doctors are available.
