

Secretary Report from 29.03.2026 to 19.05.2026.

17.04.2026: A State level Orientation Program on Promotion of Women –Led Entrepreneurship in Jharkhand was organized under RAMP Scheme at JIIDCO. RAMP is a World Bank funded program of about 70 Cr project for the development of MSME. JIIDCO is the main implementing agency for RAMP in Jharkhand. It was an overview for the RAMP Program. This program will run till 2027. It was attended by President, Sri Randhir Kr. Sharma.

20.04.2026: A Stakeholder consultation on ‘Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) initiative under GST with special emphasis on MSME taxpayers was organized in the Office of Principal Accountant General (Audit) at AG Office Doranda, Ranchi. Mrs. Indu Agarwal, Principal Accountant general (Audit) Jharkhand chaired the meeting. The meeting objective was to obtain stakeholder’s insights, suggestions and challenges faced on Ease of Doing Business initiatives under GST.
